

Following 6 places were chosen for my questionare. For each of these places few questions were prepared.


- The university

- Rio




Respondents

- about 1/3 were Greek.













- Why is it not a safe place?

It is a very important place for students, they usually get there by the means of public transport. Students like this place, but they would appreciate repaired buildings and clener environment.













- Why is it not a safe place?

Students like the city center and they usually get there by foot or public transport. A lot of people would like the place to be cleaner with more trash cans.













- Why is it not a safe place?

Students like this place, but they feel less safe here as opposed to the previous places. They usually get there by foot or with car/taxi. Majority of people feel no need for a change.











- Why is it not a safe place?

 - It is a beautiful church, it makes me feel calm and in peace.


All the students who have visited the church likes it and feels comfortable here. The surrounding area of the church could use more lights.




- What changes do you have in mind?
